- **Tuesday September 5th, 2023:** Grade 9 Orientation Day. ONLY Gr. 9 students to report to school. A separate email will be sent to all grade 9 students and parents/guardian with more details.
- Wednesday September 6th, 2023: First day of school for grades 10-12. ALL students in Grades 9-12 to report to school.
- Thursday September 7-8, 2023: All students to report to school Cafeteria services will commence on Wednesday September 6, 2023. All days from September 5-8 are full school days with regular school bus service running. Please ensure that your child is dropped off prior to the first bell so that they are able to get to class on time.

Please note that school starts at 8:28am. students are considered late to class if they arrive after the bell at 8:28am.

#### **UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Please note that as per all communication that has been sent from our school and is available on our website, <u>DGN Kilters</u> is the ONLY APPROVED UNIFORM VENDOR FOR OUR SCHOOL.
- 2. All students are expected to be in full uniform as of September 5, consisting ONLY OF THE PIECES DETAILED BELOW, as well as a pair of flat, comfortable shoes that are closed-toe and have a closed back. (no flip flops, slides, slippers, Crocs, etc.).
- 3. Students who are out of uniform will be referred to the administration. This helps us ensure a safe and secure school building at all times. No hats/caps can be worn in the building. If your child is not in uniform, they will not be admitted to class, and parents/guardians will be responsible for picking their child up or dropping off their uniform items.
- 4. \*We are aware that DGN Kilters has had some product delays and we will have the list of students that are waiting for uniform items. In the event that your child is waiting for uniform pieces, please note that only black dress pants (NO LEGGINGS AND/OR YOGA PANTS, JEANS, SHORTS, OR TRACK PANTS) and white golf shirts or plain white t-shirts can be worn as they wait for their uniform items to be delivered. Students must get a note from administration to show their classroom teachers.

#### **BUSSING & TRANSPORTATION**

- Bussing will resume on Tuesday, September 5th, 2023.

- Students may only access the bus route which corresponds to the information given at <u>www.schoolbuscity.com</u>. Students who ride to or from school on a bus they are not assigned to, for whatever reason, will be subject to the school code of conduct.
- It is important that students arrive at their designated bus stop five minutes prior to the posted pick-up time. During the first week of school, we suggest arriving 10 minutes prior to the posted pick-up time.
- Parents/guardians are reminded to refer to the Late Bus Report on the Student Transportation Services website at <u>www.schoolbuscity.com</u> each morning to determine if the school vehicle used by their child is delayed.
